## Board Meeting Minutes

October 11, 2016

Minutes from September 13, 2016 were approved by consensus as submitted.

### Financials:

Treasurer Lori Garcy reported. This was a "very low income month, an odd month". Also very low expenses. Steve Brenner submitted a bill for \$146. Discussion followed on Jean Lawrence's class cancellation...some refunds may happen. Lori is in the process of moving BAA's account from Key Bank to NW Credit Union.

### Gallery Committee:

Lori reported that she's creating a Home for the Holidays postcard which will include the BAA Christmas Art Market and Holiday Art Show. Bville Chamber will print the postcard.
